Henry Mancini Studio

The Mancini Studio, Room 2646, serves as a composer's studio, a recording studio, and a high tech classroom.

Plans are underway to renovate the studio in early 2008. It was last updated in 1998. Fifty thousand dollars in funding will upgrade the studio, with a new layout of equipment as well as near field and theater surround speakers systems and a control surface mixing console. We will be upgrading to the complete Vienna Instruments sample library and purchasing additional East West Quantum Leap Symphonic Libraries. Our projection system will be replaced with a 1080P High Definition projector or large flat screen for display of computer and high definition DVD video images. We also plan on purchasing additional microphones and upgrading our Apple G5 computer to a four or eight Intel processor MacPro computer.
